Our Curriculum

Pupils will be guided, supported and challenged through the curriculum by highly skilled and knowledgeable staff. The Trust will work with schools and its associates to provide bespoke support and improvement activities of the highest quality.

At Hayle Academy, digital devices for each child allow us to offer blended learning. Students use devices as well as books for effective feedback, assessment and improved accessibility – so that they can adapt their learning to suit them. This is a digital world and we make sure that they are prepared for it.



Structure of the Curriculum

Years 7, 8 & 9 - Key Stage 3

 Key knowledge and skills are built up across a broad range of subjects, creating a foundation for future study.

Years 10 & 11 - Key Stage 4

• Examination courses begin, predominantly GCSE courses

Key Stage 3 Statutory Curriculum

Our broad and balanced curriculum includes the study of:

- Key Stage 3 core curriculum: English, Maths and Science.
- Key Stage 3 foundation subjects: Art, Design Technology, Food Studies, History, Geography, French, Computer Science, Music, Performing Arts, PE, Global Values (Citizenship, Religious Education, PSHE, Relationship and Sex Education).

Key Stage 4 Statutory Curriculum

Our broad and balanced curriculum includes the study of:

- English, Maths and Science (Double or Separate).
- Core PE and Global Values (including RSE, RE, PSHE).
- Four options with at least one from History or Geography, and a further three from Computer Science, French, Hospitality and Catering, Music, Art and Design, DT, Performing Arts, Sport, Travel and Tourism and Health and Social Care.
