Our school provides a full and varied learning experience for children between the ages of 4 -11. In 2017, we joined Truro and Penwith Academy Trust (TPAT), which gives us great opportunities to work with our local partner schools, as well as having excellent links with Cape Cornwall Secondary School, who are also part of the Trust.

Through experiences that pique curiosity, and a sense of adventure, we strive to inspire a love of learning; a love of reading; and a love of nature. With a rich and diverse curriculum in our classrooms, we also take full advantage of our stunning surroundings, extending the journey of learning and wonder into forest and beach school. We are looking forward to developing a section of our field into a forest school area, with a poly tunnel, to broaden our skills to grow from field to plate!
