Our curriculum is coherently planned around individual subjects rather than topics. This ensures that everything we teach is planned with a secure progression of knowledge and skills. Links are drawn between related learning points which also ensures prior learning is recapped often within a different subject.

Our School Structure

We are a two-form entry school with space for over 400 children over 14 classes.

We are set in the heart of Liskeard a stones throw away from the fishing village of Looe. The school is set in a large area where the children have access to green fields and fresh air. There's room for football, netball, bike riding and many other outdoor activities which are crucial to the children's wellbeing and health.
