Tywardreath has its own unique identity and is a truly inspirational place to learn and work. Our dedicated and talented team are committed to making learning both exciting and challenging.



## Our Curriculum

Our curriculum is designed to inspire and develop high aspirations in all of our children so that they have the confidence and abilities to be the best they can be and at its heart this includes developing pupils understanding of cultural diversity, raising their awareness of environmental issues, providing strong role models including those of inspiring women, maintaining a sense of pride in our heritage and providing a strong moral compass.

Our curriculum and programme of study also considers how information is stored within the long-term memory. By carefully planning sequences of lessons where there is a clear progression of skills, knowledge and vocabulary, pupils are able to build on previous learning by making explicit links and so remember more.

When designing our curriculum and programmes of study we considered how these schemas build and strengthen over time, both within the subject and across the curriculum so that our pupils learning potential can be maximised.

## Our School Structure

The school currently has 300 children on roll in eleven classes. Two parallel EYFS classes, 3 KS1 classes and 6 KS2 classes.
